Show Rules:

- 1.ASTM/SEI approved helmets must be worn by anyone jumping. ASTM/SEI approved helmets are encouraged for all riders at all times while mounted and rider safety equipment (including protective vests) will not penalized in any class.
- 2.Cross entry between beginner horse/pony and beginner rider divisions is not permitted.
- 3.VA department of Agriculture requires all horses on the show grounds have a current (within 12 months) negative coggins.
- 4.BRHF membership is not required to compete in any class.
- 5.Dogs must be on a leash at all times.
- 6.The Roanoke Valley Horsemen’s Association, Green Hill Park Equestrian Center, Blue Ridge Horse Force, show management, any members, families, organizers, volunteers, property owners or employees, assume no responsibility in case of loss, injury, or damage to persons, horses or personal property for any cause and admittance, and entries are accepted only on this basis.

- 8.Stalls are available for \$20/day of the show. Please contact Tammy Nichols if you need an overnight stall for Friday night. You are responsible for supplying your own bedding and stripping your own stall at the end of show.
- 9.Scratches must be made prior to the start of the class.
- 10.RVHA Team Equitation Challenge** (Class T1 thru T6) This is a collection of equitation classes to be entered as a team from an AEL, 4H, Pony Club, or Barn Team. It is open to junior riders under the age of 18 that will be placed individually, but championship points will be awarded to the team with the highest points. Teams can have at most 2 riders per class, and riders cannot cross enter into other levels. Champion and reserve will be determined by earning points from their highest placed rider in each class. Level 1 classes are open to riders that have not competed over fences. Level 2 classes are open to riders that have not shown over 2ft. Level 3 division classes are open to all junior riders. Horses may cross enter the different levels, but riders may not. You do not need to have a full team to enter the team competition. Team members may enter other non team classes. Each team rider must complete an show entry form, provide a coggins for the horse and get a back number assigned in the show office. Coach should submit the team form to the show office.
